



Getting Started with Libby

(iOS) Downloading & signing into the Libby app

1. Open  (Apple App store).
2. Tap search within the app store.
3. Type 'Libby' into search bar, and select Libby, By Overdrive.
4. Tap install.
6. Once installed open the Libby app.
7. Tap Yes when Libby asks if you have a library card.
8. Tap I'll search for a Library to type in Antlers Public Library
9. Tap Enter Library Account Details to enter your library card number and password.

(Android) Downloading & signing into the Libby app

1. Open  (Google Play).
2. Search for 'Libby' and select Libby, by Overdrive.
3. Tap Install.
5. Once installed open the Libby app.
6. Tap Yes when Libby asks if you have a library card.
7. Tap I'll search for a Library to type in Antlers Public Library
8. Tap Enter Library Account Details to enter your library card number and password.

(Kindle) Downloading - Please ask the Librarian for special instructions.

Libby Basics

1. Tap  (Library) to browse the library's entire digital collection.
Filters: Just added, popular, available now, subjects, etc.
2. Tap  (Search) to search for something specific.
3. Type into the search bar a book you would like to read or listen to.
6. The difference between the eBook and audiobook  format (if applicable).

Place a hold vs borrow a title

If an item is available you may "Borrow" it.

If it is not available you may place a "Hold" on it until it is available.

- a. Tap Place Hold next to (Title) in the audiobook format, then confirm.
 - i. Tap Keep Browsing to return to the most recent search results.
- b. Tap on the jacket cover of (Title) in the eBook format to view its title details.
 - i. Tap Borrow. (If available)
 - ii. Tap the underlined lending period, located above the title, to change.
 - iii. Tap Borrow again to confirm.

Key eBook features

1. On the bottom of your screen Tap the Book Icon 
2. The title is downloaded for offline use when using Wi-Fi.
 - a. Tap to read in Libby.
3. View reading progress in the footer menu.
4. Tap the center of the screen to hide the progress bars/reader menu.
5. Tap the right side of the screen to page forward in the book.
6. Tap the center of the screen to make the progress bars/reader menu reappear.
 - a. Tap  to make changes to the appearance.
 - b. Tap Hide to return to the text.
7. Tap Back in the upper left corner to leave the eBook. This should place you on the  (Shelf).

How to Open an Audiobook

1. Open (Title) from your Shelf by tapping Open Audiobook.
2. View progress in the header menu.
3. Tap play to begin playing the audiobook.
4. Tap pause to stop the audiobook.
5. Leave the audiobook by tapping Back.

Review the Libby menu

1. Tap  (Menu).
2. Tap Manage Notifications to manage notifications about your loans and holds.
 - By default, iOS and Android devices will get push notifications. You can turn them off or enable in-app notifications.
 - When a hold becomes available, you'll receive an in-app notification and you have 3 days to act on it. Borrow, Deliver Later, or Cancel. If you do not act during the 3-day pickup window, the "deliver after seven days" option will be automatically applied as a one-time courtesy.
3. Tap Back to return to the main menu.

Kids & Teens eReading Rooms

Young readers can set their *Preferences* to only see Juvenile or Young Adult content.

1. To set preferences: In a list or in search results, tap Preferences.
2. Adjust your filters and default sorting option to Juvenile or Young Adult
3. Tap Apply Preferences.

They can also visit the Explore tab and navigate to the Kids or Teens Guides to browse curated eReading Rooms.
